

CHRISTMAS IS THE SEASON OF GIVING - WHAT GIFT WILL YOU SHARE?

"Out of sheer generosity he put us in right standing with himself. A pure gift. He got us out of the mess we're in and restored us to where he always wanted us to be. And he did it by means of Jesus Christ. God sacrificed Jesus on the altar of the world to clear that world of sin." Romans 3:24-25 (The Message)

The greatest gift you've ever been given wasn't bought in a store. No cash exchanged hands. It wasn't even wrapped. Yet it cost the Giver everything.

The Bible says God sent his Son to Earth to give you the greatest gift ever. He came to Earth to die—so that you could be made right with God. Romans 3:24-25 says, "Out of sheer generosity he put us in right standing with himself. A pure gift. He got us out of the mess we're in and restored us to where he always wanted us to be. And he did it by means of Jesus Christ. God sacrificed Jesus on the altar of the world to clear that world of sin." (The Message)

So why did Jesus have to die? Let's go back to the basics of peoples' problem and God's solution.

- Nobody's perfect. I've never met a single person who has claimed to be perfect. I don't
 measure up to my own expectations, much less God's perfect standard. Neither do you or
 anyone else. We've all blown it. The Bible says, "All of us have sinned and fallen short of God's
 glory" (Romans 3:23 CEV).
- **God is just.** God wants to be fair. When somebody breaks a law, there must be a penalty for it. When you break humanity's laws, you pay humanity's penalty. When you break God's laws, you pay God's penalty. The Bible says, *"The wages of sin is death"* (Romans 6:23 NIV).
- Jesus paid the price for our sin. The Bible says, "God took the sinless Christ and poured into him our sins. Then, in exchange, he poured God's goodness into us!" (2 Corinthians 5:21 TLB). Jesus took on my sin and your sin and all the sin that has ever been committed. That's the Good News, the Gospel. Jesus paid the price we could never pay for ourselves.
- You must decide whether to accept God's free gift. God gave you a free gift of salvation
 when Jesus took your sin upon himself. But it's a gift you must receive. The Bible says, "Yet to
 all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children
 of God" (John 1:12 NIV).

Will you accept God's gift of salvation? Have you accepted God's free gift yet? Have you been baptized yet? It's one thing to understand the basics of how to have a relationship with Jesus. It's another to accept the gift. God's free gift – Jesus Christ, is the greatest gift to humanity. He is our redemption and salvation. As THE GREATEST to us, we are also given the privilege to share Christ with our families, friends, neighbors and strangers. Will you share Christ with your family and friends this Christmas? Will

you give your family and friends God's redemptive gift this Christmas? Here's the promise of this marvelous gift:

"Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!" (John 1:29 (ESV)

Redemption is when somebody pays for your sins so that you can be forgiven and walk away justified. They do your time. They pay your penalty. All the things you've done wrong are paid for by somebody else. That's what God did for humanity in His gift given to us in Christ Jesus on Christmas day. Jesus didn't just come to Earth at Christmas. He also lived a perfect life so that his sacrifice was enough to satisfy God's judgment. All of our sins were paid for on the cross. And that is the reason for this season! Christmas comes with the best news ever—and a choice: What are you going to do with Jesus this Christmas?

My challenge for all PLUM families this Christmas is for us to share Christ with our families and friends. Pass on this GOOD NEWS of God's redemption and salvation to the world. Be the giver of the greatest gift and change lives forever.
